Medicare is the national program that provides health insurance for people 65 and older, people with disabilities, and people under 65 who are disabled. The cost of Medicare is based on the amount of earnings you had in the past. The first part of Medicare is called Part A and covers hospital care, skilled nursing care, and hospice care. The second part is called Part B and covers medical services, including doctor visits, hospital care, and durable medical equipment. Part C is called Medicare Advantage and is an alternative way to get Medicare benefits. Part D is called Medicare Prescription Drug Coverage and covers the cost of prescription drugs.
