 - You feel that you are getting worse
- Sign medications as prescribed
- Do not eat solid food, milk or dairy products while you are having diarrhea. Only soft foods like soups, broths, and applesauce until you are feeling better. Eat a BRAT diet (bananas, rice, applesauce, toast) until you are feeling better.
- Call health care provider or call 911 if you are having trouble breathing while you are having diarrhea.

CAUTION:
