During pregnancy, there are a series of prenatal tests or exams ordered to ensure the health of mom and baby. The following is a general timeline of what tests or exams to expect during your pregnancy.\* Additional tests (not listed) may be ordered at the discretion of your provider.

**Initial appointment (8-9 weeks gestation)**

- Urinalysis
- Breast exam
- Pap/ pelvic & cultures
  - Chlamydia
  - Gonorrhea
- Complete Blood Count (CBC)
  - Hemoglobin/Hematocrit
  - Blood type/Rh Factor
  - Syphilis
  - Rubella antibody
  - HIV
  - Hepatitis B
- Flu vaccination (seasonal and highly recommended)

**20-28 weeks gestation**

- Partial blood count (PBC)
- Hemoglobin/Hematocrit
- Antibody screen (ABO and Rh)
- Glucose tolerance test (GTT)
- Rh(D)GAM injection (if patient is Rh-negative)

**30-36 weeks gestation**

- Group B strep
- Non fetal stress test

**Office visit schedule**

- After first visit, every 4 weeks up to 28 weeks
- From 28-36 weeks, you will be seen every 2 weeks
- From 36 weeks to delivery you will be seen weekly

**OB make visit (between 9-10 weeks gestation)**

- 10 weeks gestation**
- Early/Cervix Screen

**Every visit you can anticipate**

- Weight
- Blood pressure
- Urine dip test
- Growth of the uterus
- Baby's heartbeat
- Drug screen (per provider discretion)

- Approximately 20 weeks gestation**
- Anatomy ultrasound
