PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

Please arrive at the Hospital at \_\_\_\_\_ AM/PM on \_\_\_\_\_.
If there is a change, expect a phone call from your surgeon or the Hospital.

- 1. Please report to the Patient Services Center on the day of surgery for additional info if instructed to do so by your nurse, then you will report to Surgical Services Department. (2nd floor)
2. Call surgeon if you feel ill or have an elevated temperature
3. Follow specific surgeon instructions
4. No food / drink / gum or mints after 10 midnight before surgery
5. No smoking after midnight
6. No alcohol 24 hours before surgery
7. No diet pills / herbs 10 days before surgery
8. Aspirin products, NSAIDS (non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs), anti-inflammatory and arthritis medications need to be stopped 5 days prior to surgery unless otherwise instructed. They may cause increased bleeding after surgery.
9. Follow your doctor's insulin and hypoglycemia medication orders
10. Tylenol is permitted
11. No nail/paint or street drugs at least 70 hours prior to surgery
12. Shower using Chlorhexidine Gluconate (CHG) or Antiseptical Soap the night before and the morning of surgery.
13. Joint & Sprain Patients: Shower using Chlorhexidine Gluconate (CHG) 3 days consecutively before and the morning of surgery.
Open Heart/1/ Coroner Patients: Shower using Chlorhexidine Gluconate (CHG) 4 days consecutively before and the morning of surgery.
14. No lotions / powder / vaginal make up or deodorant
15. Remove all body piercings, acrylic nails and nail polish
16. Brush teeth, do not swallow water
17. Wear loose comfortable clothing and low heeled shoes
18. Do not wear contacts to the hospital. Please wear your glasses and bring a case to store them.
19. No green/ spray tans 24 hours prior to procedure. Drink plenty of fluids throughout evening
20. No tampons, use pads if necessary
21. An adult companion must be present to drive you home from hospital
22. There is responsible adult remain at hospital throughout your surgery
23. Only two visitors are allowed per patient, please designate one spokesperson per family. Only children over the age of 12 are allowed per the visitor policy.
24. Bring your CPAP machine if necessary.
