**When to refer to the McLaren Macomb out patient seizure/epilepsy clinic**

*Any patient with a new diagnosis of seizures/epilepsy should be referred to the epilepsy clinic.*

*Any patient with an existing diagnosis of seizures/epilepsy and/or on anti-seizure medication should be offered a follow up in the epilepsy clinic, if they do not have /have not seen a seizure specialist.*

**Clinical Basis:**

- A. Co-morbid conditions seen in seizure/epilepsy patients
  - 80% of patients with a brain-tumor develop seizures
  - 60% to 80% of patients with a stroke, or brain bleed develop seizures
  - 800% of patient with a head injury and develop seizures.
- B. Delay in Diagnosis and Treatment can lead to consequences such as but not limited to falls, sprains, strains, fractures, head injury, or even sudden death.  
*(On average it takes 12 years for a patient with epilepsy to be diagnosed and treated optimally, consequently referral can to a seizure specialist/ epileptologist improves outcomes, and quality of life.*
