CARDIAC CATHETERIZATION AND
PERCUTANEOUS CORONARY INTERVENTION
PRE-PROCEDURE
1. Please Obtain Permits for EITHER: [ ] Please obtain old films
[ ] Cardiac Cath. Only: Cardiac Catheterization and Angiography, Coronary Angiographies and other
angiographies as may be necessary.
[ ] Cath/Prostate/PCI: Pulmonary Artery Catheter Insertion, Arterial Line Insertion, Temporary Pacemaker,
Intra-Aortic Balloon Pump Insertion and Coronary Artery Bypass Surgery, Blood Transfusion as may be
necessary. Or
[ ] Cardiac Bypass (Cardiac Bypass) for standby.
2. Obtain height and weight within 24 hours of procedure - do not use stated weight
3. VITAL SIGNS: Blood pressure, pulse, respiratory rate, temperature prior to procedure
4. NPO: Prior to procedure clip and prep [ ] groin [ ] arm [ ] wrist
[ ] Shower or bath the night before or the morning of the procedure
[ ] Have patient void on call to catheterization lab
[ ] Foley if deemed necessary by RN
5. NPO: For A.M. procedure NPO after midnight. For P.M. procedure NPO after Clear Liquid breakfast.
6. Start IV in the arm opposite the procedure site or in the left arm if possible
• Cardiac Cath. Start IV with #18 intracath with fluids per hydration protocol
• Cath/Prostate/PCI Start 1 IV site
• #1 - 18 g with fluids per hydration protocol
7. LABS: Ensure results are on the chart
• CBC, BUN, PT and PTT within 7 days of procedure
• Urine HCG for women of childbearing age < 60, unless prior hysterectomy
• Blood HCG if dialysis or renal failure patient
8. STG: If not done within last 7 days, if done in past 7 days, please place daily on chart
9. For any Chest Pain: Do STG (ECG, Nitroglycerin 0.4 mg sublingual EVERY 5 min up to 3 doses, maintain SBP
greater than 100 notify call cardiologist)
10. MEDS: Continue all oral medications despite NPO orders. Glucometer prior to procedure if patient diabetic
[ ] Sing Statins or Mefenamic acid containing medications day of procedure and for 48 hours
[ ] Clozapine (ZANEXIN) 150 mg PO for sedation PRN x 1 dose
[ ] Diphenhydramine (BENADRYL) 50 mg PO for sedation PRN x 1 dose
[ ] Midazolam (Versed) 1 mg IVP over 2 minutes PRN for anxiety x 1 dose
[ ] Aspirin 81 mg PO on arrival. HOLD if patient has taken at home
[ ] Aspirin 325 mg PO on arrival. HOLD if patient has taken at home
[ ] Clopidogrel (PLAVIX) 300 mg PO x 1 dose if not already received
[ ] Clopidogrel (PLAVIX) 75 mg PO day of intervention
[ ] Prasugrel (Effient) 60 mg PO loading dose if not already taking
[ ] Prasugrel (Effient) 10 mg PO day of intervention
[ ] Ticagrelor (Brilinta) 180 mg PO loading dose if not already taking
[ ] Ticagrelor (Brilinta) 90 mg PO day of intervention
11. Notify Physician if patient has a history of contrast allergy.
[ ] Pre-mediations for contrast allergy (or possible contrast allergy)
[ ] Methylprednisolone (SOLU-MEDROL) 120 mg IV evening before and morning
of procedure for allergy to contrast
[ ] Fentanyl (FENTORA) 20 mg IVP morning of procedure for allergy to contrast
[ ] Diphenhydramine (BENADRYL) 50 mg IVP morning of procedure for allergy to contrast
12. For Radial or Brachial Approach only
[ ] Remove all jewelry from upper extremities, apply identification & Allergy bands on opposite wrist
13. Return and document Allen's Test. Notify physician if greater than 5 secs
14. Hold AM dose of diuretic
